24.20	Right bank of Nestucca River bears NE. and SW.; asc. 70 ft. over SE. slope.
30.60	Spur, slopes SE.; desc. 10 ft. over SW. slope.
32.80	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course SE.; asc. 115 ft. over NE. slope, changing to E. slope.
39.43	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

59.145	Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31. Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

79.45	The cor. of Tps. 3 and 4 S., Rs. 7 and 8 W. Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, alder, maple, wild cherry and cascara; undergrowth, vine maple, salal, fern, huckleberry, willow, devil's club and nettle.
