Chains 53.60	Spur, slopes S. 30° W.; descend 110 ft. over W. slope.
53.74	Point for the W 1/16 sec. cor. of Section 34 only. Set on iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap std.
