N 1/16 S 19 BT.</p> <p>A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 65° E., 50 lks. dist., mhd. N 1/16 S 19 BT.</p> <p>The corner falls on a spur, slopes N. 20° W.</p> <p>Descend 497 ft. over steep NE. slope.</p>
38.16	<p>Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of Section 24 only, on the E. bdy. of T. 1 S., R. 9 W., at midpoint latitudinally.</p> <p>Set on iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mhd.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">T 1 S $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 R 9 W 1958</p> <p>from which</p> <p>A hemlock, 43 ins. diam., bears S. 29° W., $63\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mhd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 BT.</p> <p>A hemlock, 58 ins. diam., bears N. 37° W., 83 lks. dist., mhd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 BT.</p> <p>Descend 73 ft. over steep NE. slope.</p>
39.50	Ravine, drains N. 50° W.; continue over NW. slope.
39.83	Branch, 4 lks. wide, course N. 50° W.; ascend 52 ft. over SW. slope.
45.34	Spur, slopes W.; descend 38 ft. over N. slope.

T 1 S RSW S 18 BT.</p> <p>A hemlock, 41 ins. diam., bears S. 31° E., 87 lks. dist., mhd. T 1 S RSW S 19 BT.</p> <p>Deposit the basalt stone alongside the iron post.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay with rock outcroppings.</p>
