I found 3/4" galv. pipe 18" above the ground. Along side is a 3"X½" post 10" above the ground Mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on south and $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on North sides. It is not the original post.

I found a rotted hemlock stump, S.5°W., 17Lks. with marks rotted away. A yellow tin is on the stump marked; "Do Not Destroy."

The N.E. BT is in its proper bearing and distance but all marks are rotted away.
