The original post and witnesses are gone. A 30" spruce marked by Billy Anderson, Tilla. Co engineer, bears S.9°W., $18\frac{1}{2}$ ft. with visible marks $\frac{1}{2}$ S. Billy Anderson testified to the fact that he saw one of the original witness trees at this corner and he marked the 30" spruce mentioned above and set a iron shaft at ppint for the corner, a logging operation caused the iron shaft to be buried or lost.

Therefore Iset a 6"x6" spruce 1imb 24" high Mkd. $\frac{1}{2}$ S6 on S. side.

Also I set a 12x6x6 stone Mkd. x on top and $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face. This stone is 12^m beneath the SW face of the ground on N. side of above post.
