Jear Mr. Carlich:

Enclosed herewith are returned tracings of US FS survey in Section 11, Township 5 South, Range 10 West of W.M.

The words "I scribed" and "Found" have been added to bearing trees noted on the survey plat and field notes.

Paragraph 319 Manual of Survey Instructions specify measurements of bearing trees shall be to "center of tree at root crown". These are the specifications we follow. Note that the country top of policy.

I noticed that US FS form R6-7100-57 (9/66) was out of the letter after I had sealed it. I enclosed it in a separate envelop and mailed it the same day. You should have received it at the same time. It is merely information on the southwest corner and does not convey any message other than what is on the plat itself plus the history of the corner. I do not have another copy of this form, as the US FS required all I had.

I acknowledge the misuse of Standard corners and have crossed it out on the notes.

I suggest you might send me a copy of your "Tillamook County Surveyor's Record", so I can have it on file next time I do a survey in Tillamook County. It might be well to send a copy to Leonard Whitmore U.S. F.S. so they will know what records you would like. The F.S. contract specifies many things, including the form of notes to file.

I trust everything is in order and that you will acknowledge receipt of notes to Leonard Whitmore. Thank you for the corrections.
