CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTA

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally set in November of 1880. He set a stone and built a stone mound, but scribed no BT's. In 1887 W.W. Hayes, the Tillamook County Surveyor set appost and marked 4 BT snags.

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Description of corner evidence found:

A 3/4 pipe 30" above ground. An old wooden post 12" long in rock mound with scribing visible from which

A 14" fir brs N41langleE 10.5 ft; scribing visible

A 15" alder brs $542 \frac{1}{2}$ E 19.0 ft; bark scribed

A 15" alder brs S29W 35.5 ft. bark scribed

A 20" fir brs N31W 9.0 ft. scribing visible

1887 Bt's in their proper location, but scribing rotted off.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner


Set 2" x 30" iron pipe with brass cap mkd T 5S R 9 W

20 | 21 Set 3/4" pipe and old post beside corner and 29 28 piled stones around pipe 1969

650 Set a 6' steel post north of corner with F.S. Boundary sign facing east

Set a 6' steel post west of corner with F.S. boundary sign facing south

Placed BT tags on all BT's. Painted red band on all BT's.
