


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner established in 1878 by Henry Meldrum




Description of corner evidence found:

Found 1" pipe with original post wired to it - set by M. Whitmore in 1964
In 1948 M. Whitmore found scribing on post mkd "1/2" on north side

- 50" fir sag brs. S75E 6.6 ft
- 48" fir snag brs. N50W (N35W) 49.0 ft
- 28" fir brs. S77W 23.2 ft
face healed
- 14" fir brs. N56 1/2 E 26.4 ft
face healed

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set 2"x30" iron pipe with brass cap mkd



Set fence post ± 5 ft east facing north
