25"Hem bears $86\frac{1}{2}$ E 19.8 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S21 BT RS707. 16"Hem bears 833W'44.6 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S20 BT. Logging road bears North 164 ft., N70E by S70W. Dry ravine bears South 45 ft.; slopes west. Found a 3/4" iron pipe west 10.4".

Set 4" x 4" x 50" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. SE of corner pipe. Oregon State Forestry Department metal location poster on 25" Hem BT. Also poster on 6' Fir stump on North edge of logging road North 181.5'
