CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original cornectablishment:

Corner established by W. P. Wright in 1882 under G. L. O. Contract No. 442. For this corner Wright set a scribed post, from which he scribed two bearing trees: A Spruce 14 ins. bears N 88° E 58 lks dist. A Spruce 12 ins. diam. bears S 10° W 57 lks. dist.

On County Survey Plat A-165 G.E. Davis, Deputy County Surveyor, Shows the following bearing trees at this corner: Spruce 12" diam S 10° W 37.5 ft. Spruce 14" diam N 88° E 38.0 ft. Davis does not say wether he set these trees or found them. No date is given on Davis' survey.

CORNER DIAGRAM T2S, RIOW, W.M.


In county Survey Book P-16, Page 47, C. A. Dunn reports the following bearing trees at this corner: 40" Spruce S 52° 29' W 31.0 ft. 30" Spruce N 52° 50' E 25.5 ft. Dunn does not say whether he found or set these B. T's.

In County Survey Book 3, Page 301, C. G. Collard, L.S. 376, reports:
" on May 8,1969, I found the two Spruce BTs (now rotting stumps) with a scribed 'BT' plainly evident on both. From these original bearing trees I set a 3/4" iron pipe with 3 inch brass cap for the 1/4 corner. I marked new bearing trees as follows: 16" Fir brs. N 39° E 41.8 ft. scribed BT-S25-376. 14" Fir brs. S 75° W 23.7 feet, scribed BT -S36-376.

Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner I found Collard's 3 inch brass cap monument on a 3/4" iron pipe that sticks 24 inches above ground. The monument is set in the bottom of a small creek that runs North and South. I also found both original B. T's: 20" rotten Spruce Stump brs. S 86° E 38.0 ft. to face with portion of original scribing visible. Case hardened core of rotten Spruce stump brs. S 13° W 37.0 ft. to face with full original scribing still visible. Collard's bearing trees are still present and they bear as reported by him in May, 1969. Collard's Brass cap is stamped as shown bellow:

I did not find any trace of the bearing trees reported by G. E. Davis, or C. A. Dunn.
