
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Wilson in 1890 marked a Hemlock 7" diam. for closing corner to Sec. 4 and 5 mkd. CC T 6 S R 10 W on S face, S 4 on E. and S 5 on W. face with 4 notches on E. and 2 notches on W. face from which:

Spruce 10" diam. bears S 50°E, 21 lks., mkd. T 6 S R 10 W Alder 12" diam. bears S 100W, 25 lks. mkd. T 6 S R 10 W Alder 4" diam. bears N 7^{0} W, 47 lks., mkd. T 6 S R 10 W S 4 & 5 BT



Description of corner evidence found:

Monument found:

 $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" iron pipe set by M. Whitmore in 1950 who found 2 orig. BT's fallen with visible scribing.

Hemlock stump 16" diam. bears N $39^{\circ}E$, 3.0 ft., no marks or face found (origin unknown). Down rotten spruce 7" diam. bears S $50^{\circ}E$, 7.0 ft. Possible scribe mark but not sure if orig.

Other trees all gone. Open up 40" fir, S 70°W, 4 ft. (face). Find definte chop marks, however, they date back only to 1905.

Open up 40" Douglas-fir, S., 70 ft., find possible orig. blaze, dates back to 1890. Blaze mark small and definte ax mks. not seen.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: September 13, 1979

At the point determined by M. Whitmore, which I determine to be the best evidence available, set an aluminum post (with a magnet in top and bottom) 30" long, 3" diam., 24" in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd. T 5 S R 10 W l½" pipe reset alongside aluminum post.

Accessories: Scribe 2 new BT's

Fir 32" diam. bears $S58^{O}W$, 26.5 ft. blazed and mkd., T 6 S R 10 W S 4 CC BT. Fir 31" diam. bears $S62^{O}E$, 45.8 ft. blazed and mkd.

T 6 S R 10 W S 4 CC BT. Painted face and 6" red band around each tree. Put ATTN signs on back, and nailed brass washer mkd. LS 1017 to each new BT.
