Hemlock 22" diam., S54°E,11½ lks.,partly healed face, scribing visible,(M. Whitmore 1963 BT). Hemlock, dead and down, 12" diam. bears S39°W, 46 lks.,scribing visible(M. Whitmore 1963 BT). Creek calls at 4.0 chs. S. and 17.50 Chs. S. are harmoniously related to the record.

M. Whitmore traverse notes in 1963 verify this. I determine that the call, 4.28 chs., to the east does not fit. Wilson probably did not run this half mile.
