30" Fir bears N76°W 36 lks.; now 35" snag, 30' high, scribes /4S BT visible, cruiser marks above scribing.
16" Hemlock bears S83°E 6 lks.; missing.

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " X 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2N R9W  $\frac{1}{4}$  S23 S26 1984 RS1998", 34 inches in ground, and from which a:

5" Fir bears S86°E 52.0 ft. to face; scribed X BT.
53" Fir snag bears S11°E 27.6 ft. to face; scribed \( \frac{1}{4}\)S26BT.
Snag 20' high.


