- 12" Hemlock bears S45 3/4°W 39 lks.; missing. 16" Hemlock bears N84°W 113 lks.; now 20" stub, uprotted and down, no scribes visible on open face.

- 9" Alder bears N46°E 6.3 ft. to bark scribes T2SR7WS11BT.
- 15" Alder bears S55°W 38.3 ft. to bark scribes T2SR7WS15BT.
- 13" Alder bears S55°E 71.5 ft. to bark scribes T2SR7WS14BT. Creek, 5.0 ft. wide, bears West 10.7 ft., course NO20E from

Creek, 5.0 ft. wide, bears South 21.0 ft., course N330W from same.


