ORIGINAL by Albert P. Wilson, July 5, 1891. Post, now missing, from which a:

- 30" Hemlock bears S18°E 27 lks.; now badly rotted stub, no scribing visible, bears S16°E.
- 8" Hemlock bears N52½°W 41 lks.; missing.
- 26" Fir bears  $S60^1_2$ °W 53 lks.; now 40" stub scribes T2S R7W S11 2311 BT, visible, bears  $S60^1_2$ °W 32.5 ft.
- 8" Hemlock bears N52½°E 23 1ks.; missing.

RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort, December 31, 1951 (Book 2 page 98 Tillamook Co. records).

 $1\frac{1}{2}$ " galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap in mound of stone, in place, from which a:

- 48" Fir stump bears N70°E 13.5 ft.; now 48" stump, scribes T2S R7W BT visible.
- 40" Hemlock stub bears S16°E 17.8 ft.; original BT (see above).
- 40" Fir stub bears  $S60\frac{1}{2}$ °W 32.5 ft.; original BT (see above).
- 38" Hemlock stump bears N72°W 18.5 ft.; now badly rotted stump, no scribing visible.


