40" Fir bears N48 1/2°E 57 lks.; now a 40" badly rotted stump, face chopped out, no original scribes visible. (See below.)

1" Galvanized iron pipe, 72" in ground; in place.

84" Fir stump bears North 3.2 ft.; now in place with scribes 1/4 BT visible.

72" Fir stump bears S06°W 33.0 ft.; now badly rotted, face found laying on ground with portions of scribes 1/4 BT visible. Rescribed Sharp's 40" Fir BT; now scribes 1/4 BT visible. Cruiser marks ZW above original face.
