
## TILLAMOOK COUNTY SURVEYORS OFFICE

1/4 Corner Common to sections 3 & 4 T.1N., R.10W., W.M



I set a 10" concrete cylinder around found 0.5.B.F. 1 1/2" iron pipe with 3" bronze cap set in 1961, (See Tillamook County Surveyors map #B-437).

History of found monument

This is a proportion corner set by 0.5.B.F.

I found this monument to be as described on the above said map and the bearing trees set at that time to now be as follows:

22" hemlock 5.44 1/2\*W. 61.8'; (now 36" rotten stump scribing visible on partially healed face).

12" hemlock N.36 1/2\*E. 42.7'; (now 15" rotten stump scribing visible on partially healed face).
