

I found a 3" brass cap in concrete, probably attached to an iron pipe as it shows up with a metal detector, approximately 10" deep set by unknown. The Tillamook County Surveyors copy of the plat of the First Addition to Fishers Subdivision, (TCS #C-100), appears to have "Con Mon" written in, the original plat

in the clerks office does not have this statement on it. I set an 84" hat section post 1.5' West.

History of Found Monument

The found monument has been used by numerous retracement surveys in these subdivisions. The Tillamook County Surveyors map numbers for these subdivisions are C-99 and C-100.

Location of Monument

This monument is located on east side of fifth street which is unimproved and full of willows at this time.
