Section corner on the west side common to Sections 6 and 7, T1N, R6W,  
W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by John A. Hulburt, September 13, 1874.  
15" x 12" x 6" stone; missing

48" Hemlock bears S45W 9 lks.; now a 34" x 15 ft. high badly rotted  
snag with scribes R T S visible on burnt out face.

RESTORATION by Lyle E. Beyers LS199 June 7, 1951 (Book 2, page 88,  
Tillamook County Records).

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground; now  
34" in ground, leaning slightly downhill, in place.

38" Fir snag bears S31E 88.4 ft.; now badly rotted with scribes  
T1N R6W S7 199 BT visible.

59" Fir stump bears N45 1/2E 64.9 ft.; now badly rotted with  
no scribes visible.

From the above pipe with marks "LS1998 1990" added, as:

22" Fir bears N14 1/2E 27.3 ft. to face; scribed T1NR6WS6BT.

15" Fir bears S04 1/2E 20.45 ft. to face; scribed T1NR6WS7BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
