(T.C.S. Map #A-719) 16" spruce S.3 W. 30.2'; (Found, now  $\star$ 30" spruce leaning southerly South 28.81' rescribed EE 1/64 S6 BT CS.The distance was measured to a finish nail with a Tillamook County Surveyors brass washer in the face between the  ${\sf B}$  and the  ${\sf T}$ ).

7" spruce N.16 E. 112 lks.; (Found, now 22" spruce with healed face 73.17' to a finish nail with a brass washer in a small blaze facing the corner) .

\*14" spruce N.53 E. 9.25' scribed EE 1/64 S31 BT CS.

The distance was measured to a finish nail with a Tillamook County Surveyors brass washer in the face between the B and the T.
