Standard section corner common to Sections 33 and 34, T1N, R8W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL by Samuel D. Snowden, September 16, 1856. Post; missing.

- 72" Fir bears N35E 30 lks.; now a 74" x 6 ft. high stump with no scribes visible.
- 32" Hemlock bears S14E 20 lks.; now a 40" badly rotted stump with scribes R8M T1S S3 visible. (W is upside down).
- 10" Hemlock bears S86W 16 lks.; missing, point falls on cutbank of old cat road.
  - 8" Hemlock bears N23W 57 lks.; missing, point falls in old cat road.

RESTORATION by Henry Meldrum, August 8, 1884. Post; missing.

- RESTORATION by Louis W. Amort RE2311, November 25, 1952 (Book 2, page 233, Tillamook County Records).
  - 1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 30" in ground, in mound of stone; found, out of place.
    - 8" Alder bears N15W 61.8 ft.; now 18" with no scribes
    - visible on partially open face. 60" Fir snag bears N57 3/4E 81.2 ft.; now a 60" x 8 ft; high stump with faint scribes visible.
    - Metal location poster on Original 72" Fir; found, laying on ground next to stump.

Reset the above pipe 34" in ground with marks "LS1998 1991" added, and from which a:

- 74" Fir stump (1856) bears N40E 19.8 ft. to face; scribed T1NR8WS34SCBT.
- 14" Alder bears N64W 53.7 ft. to barkscribes T1NR8WS33SCBT.

Metal location poster on new BTs, and 1952 Alder BT.
3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new Fir BT. Present and witnessed by David B. Buchholz and Clifford R. Foster.
