RESTORATION by U.G. Jackson, County Surveyor, February, 1913 (Not Recorded).

Richard A. Morris, (Book 2, Page 333, Tillamook County Records)reports finding a 4"x4"x30" scribed Fir post, (missing) with a 1"x52" galvanized iron pipe, 28" in ground wired to the East side of the post; found pipe with wire wrapped around it laying on ground out of place.

REWITNESSED by William E. Anderson, RE1697, March 21, 1956, (Book 2, Page 333, Tillamook County Records).

From above pipe a:
