

Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 3" diameter O.S.B.F. Brass Cap under the root system				
of a 12" dia. Hemlock, down 0.5'. No original evidence was found and the monument was proportioned on Map B-437 (1959).				
Rewitness Book 2 Page 489 was the corner report reflecting the work done on Map B-437. The intent of this rewitness is to perpetuate the position of the proportioned corner. Found a white painted cedar post lying near the monument.				
(Map B-437) – Found rotten remains of (32" Hemlock bears S 78° W 7.7'), no visible marks.				
(Map B-437) – Found rotten remains of (30" Hemlock bears S 15° E 2.2'), no visible marks.				
(Map B-437) – Found rotten remains of (14" Hemlock bears N 11 1/2° W 15.9'), no visible marks.				
(Map B-437) – Found rotten remains of (16" Hemlock bears N 77° E 39.2'), no visible marks.

Monument Found (Procedures and Description): After falling the Hemlock and cutting out the root system to expose the monument, we ran a control traverse to the monument from GPS established control. The Oregon North Zone State Plane in NAD 83/91 grid coordinate for the position is N = 726075.430, E = 7330887.101 U.S. Survey Feet. Convergence = -2°24'52.59333", Grid Scale = 0.99992388.

Sketch of Found Monument:



New accessories set: Set 120 lbs. of concrete in a 12" dia. cylinder around the monument. Set 72" hat section post with a yellow metal location tag East 3.0' from the monument.

New Bearing Trees set:

- *18" dia. Spruce bears N 4° W 17.6' scribed, "T2N R10W S33 BT", tagged and painted.
 *19" dia. Spruce bears N 73° E 26.7' scribed, "T2N R10W S34 BT", tagged and painted.
 *19" dia. Spruce bears S 33° E 17.0' scribed, "T1N R10W S3 BT", tagged and painted.
 *15" dia. D. Fir bears S 87° W 26.9' scribed, "T1N R10W S4 BT", tagged and painted.

- * Indicates an aluminum nail with a washer marked, "Till. Co. Surveyor" in the face of the blaze between the scribed "B" and "T" and a yellow metal location tag affixed.

Location & Comments: Monument is located approximately 150' West of a gravel logging road spur.
