We used metal posts and 120 pounds of concrete to reinforce the down-hill side of the monument. We then placed a 12" diameter plastic cylinder and 120 pounds of concrete around monument. Found a broken and rotten white painted cedar post lying on the ground next to the found monument. All original GLO bearing trees are gone. Found a 27" diameter Fir tree with a healed face, at position (was a 7" diameter Fir tree bearing South 37° East 129.2' Rewitness Book 2, Page 423). Found a 5' tall x 48" rotten Cedar stump with visible scribing, at position (was a 48" diameter Cedar stump bearing North 27-1/2° West 41.7' Rewitness Book 2, Page 423). Found a 6' tall x 52" rotten Fir stump with no visible scribing, at position (was a 52" diameter Fir stump bearing North 04° East 38.6' Rewitness Book 2, Page 423). The 10" diameter Alder tree bearing North 75-1/2° East 82.3 feet is gone (See Rewitness Book 7, Page 245). Found a 34" diameter Fir tree with healed face and yellow metal location tag, at position (was a 22" Fir tree bearing South 56-1/2° West 76.5 feet see Rewitness Book 7, Page 245). Found a 24" diameter Fir tree with healed face and yellow metal location tag, at position (was a 15" Fir tree bearing North 72-1/2° West 55.9 feet see
