Found a 44" diameter x 3' tall Fir stump with healed face at record position and with a yellow metal location tag attached. (Was a 30" diameter Fir tree which bears N. 1 1/2° E., 85 ½ lks. [56.43'] dist., mkd. ¼ S32 BT in BLM Field Notes Volume: OR-R0584, Page 0225). Found a 43" diameter x 4' tall Fir stump at record position, top of stump is angle cut with a partially rotted face and a scribed S5 B still visible.
