Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): The Section corner was first set in September of 1893 by Henry Meldrum. He set a wooden post and four bearing trees. In 1905 Joseph Saudero set a 4" Sharpened Spruce limb and one new accessory. In May 1946 J.H. Scott set a 3' x 1 1/4" galvanized pipe with a white post. In November of 1965 Tillamook County Surveyors office set 2 new accessories. In 1974 the Tillamook County Surveyors office set a 2" iron pipe with a 3" brass cap set in concrete at location and added a hat section post.
