Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): IN 1857, SAMUEL SNOWDEN SET A POST ON THE SOUTH BANK OF SLOUGH, 75 LINKS SOUTH OF THE TRUE SECTION CORNER, AS A WITNESS CORNER TO THE SECTION CORNER 25,26,35, AND 36; FROM WHICH HE SET FOUR BEARING TREES. IN JUNE OF 1949, W.E. ANDERSON SET A 2" IRON PIPE FOR THE WITNESS CORNER AND SET ONE BEARING TREE. IN MAY OF 1965, JOHN CARLICH FOUND AN 11/4" IRON PIPE FLUSH WITH GROUND IN THE EAST-WEST FENCE ±12' SOUTH OF THE APPARENT CENTERLINE OF TONE ROAD. HE SET A 4"X 4" WHITE POST AND A BEARING TREE. IN JANUARY OF 1958 J. CARLICH SET CORNER TAG AND PADDLE BOARD. IN DECEMBER OF 1971, J. CARLICH SET A 2" IRON PIPE WITH A 3" TILLAMOOK COUNTY BRASS CAP STAMPED "WITNESS 26 25 35 36 COR RS 287 1971" IN CEMENT AND TILE. IN 1993 AL DUNCAN FOUND A 3" TILLAMOOK COUNTY BRASS CAP IN CEMENT ON THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF TONE ROAD, AND SET 3 NEW BEARING TREES. IN NOVEMBER OF 2017 DUE TO BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION TONE ROAD WAS WIDENED AND THE WITNESS CORNER WAS BURRIED 18" DEEP AND CAPPED WITH ASPHALT; THE WITNESS CORNER WAS DUG UP AND A NEW TILLAMOOK COUNTY BRASS CAP STAMPED "W.C 26 25 35 36 2017" WITH 11/2" PIPE WAS SET ON TOP OF THE OLD MONUMENT IN CEMENT FLUSH WITH TOP OF ASPHAULT OF TONE ROAD. ALL PREVIOUS ACCESSORIES WERE DESTROYED DURING BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION.

Monument Set (Procedures and Description): THE FOUND MONUMENT WAS 18" BELOW GRADE. THE POSITION OF THE FOUND MONUMENT WAS CHECKED BY PREFORMING A DIRECT STATIC TIE AND THE POSITION WAS COMPARED TO THE 2 PREVIOUS DIRECT GPS TIES. ONCE THE POSITION WAS VERIFIED TO BE GOOD THE TOTAL STATION WAS SET UP AND LEVELED; USING THE LASER PLUMMET 2 REFERENCE MONUMENTS WERE SET IN THE ASPHALT. THE NEW MONUMENT WAS PLACED DIRECTLY ON TOP OF THE OLD MONUMENT AND CEMENT WAS PLACED AROUND THE NEW MONUMENT AND A DISTANCE- DISTANCE MEASUREMENT WAS TAKEN FROM THE 2 REFERENCE MONUMENTS TO PLACE THE EXCACT LOCATION OF THE CENTER OF THE MONUMENT. THE FINAL POSITION WAS THEN CHECKED WITH A DIRECT GPS TIE.
